WHO NEEDS 50 SHADES OF GREY?

Check out these four amazing installations in Anthracite Grey! We have seen the Anthracite Grey overtake white as the most popular colour for the Simplicity 6 now and you can see why from these amazing installations. It suits a wide range of house finishes and works well even if the windows and doors are not grey as well. Adding the blue glass gives a very contemporary and sleek look to proceedings too! The Alfresco with blue tint by Osborn Glass was achieved by them providing a tinted film which they applied to the clear 8mm glass as unfortunately tinted 8mm is not available and it helped secure this amazing order for them. Have you thought of that to help on Alfresco jobs requiring a tinted roof? We hope that you can gain some inspiration from these images. From all of us here at Milwood, many thanks to White Windows, NGT, Osborn Glass and R H Magor Joinery Services for these fantastic submissions!

White Windows, Isle of Wight

This beautiful Simplicity 6 Glass Room was supplied and installed by our Trade Partner White Windows who are based in Isle of Wight.

Their customer had an old timber outbuilding which was falling apart. It was roughly 4000mm wide by 2000mm deep. The glass was falling out and the base was on a slant as the front had sunk. Here's what company's director Matthew has to say about this project:

"They wanted a new veranda to span the width of the house, but also have an enclosed area where they could sit if the weather was bad. We decided on a 11000mm in length and 2600mm deep

glass room. The problem was that because the base was so bad, we had to start from scratch.

We demolished the existing structure and excavated the footings to 1000mm deep. Build a retaining wall, then back filled it and concreted the floor to get the correct height.

We installed new fascia and gutter above the veranda, then installed gutter guard to stop any tiles falling on the proposed new veranda glass roof. We then installed a Simplicity 6 veranda in 7016 Grey with a self-cleaning solar blue roof.

For the enclosed area we used Smart Aluminium frames, again in the 7016 Grey. We measured the roof and enclosed area so that the frame would line up with the roof bars, then we got hollow soffits sprayed to 7016 grey to fill in the rakes.

We tiled the floor inside and out using Hamble Nimbus from the spaces range at Topps Tiles.

Then we finished off with a couple of steps on the front

It was a challenge as we had to incorporate 2 different systems, the simplicity 6 veranda and smart aluminium frames. But the customer is over the moon with the finished product and it has turned out better than we could have hoped."

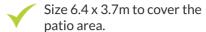


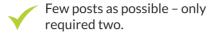
WHO NEEDS 50 SHADES OF GREY?

Last year (Osborn Glass & Windows Ltd) completed a refurb using aluminium windows and Patio doors, this formed a fantastic open planned kitchen dining area. The client had lived with the new windows and doors for about 12 months and asked if we had a solution to continue this space outside.

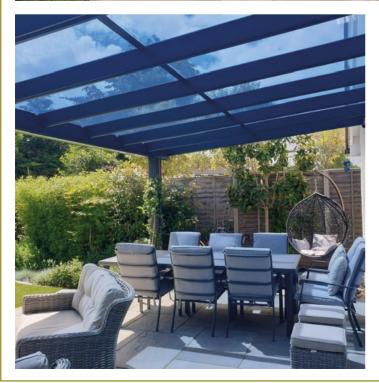

WHO NEEDS 50 SHADES OF GREY?

Another two installations in grey are by NGT Products Ltd. Here's what the company director has to say about these projects:

"We recently carried out the following installation for a client that had an existing wooden canopy that had never been watertight since it was installed by another company several years ago.

What they liked most about the new structure was the quality of the product with the Victorian upgrade and our complete service offering of dismantling and disposing of the original canopy and then installing the Simplicity 6 shown below.

At NGT we like to offer what the customer requires rather than other canopy companies that very often just want to sell what's best for them. Once we have established the clients budget meets with their 'want' we take time to go through every aspect with them and we are willing to take on a project management approach to the project when other trades are required for groundworks, lighting etc. We can be as involved as they want us to be.



Another recent installation was at a Gastro pub in North Yorkshire where we created a valuable Alfresco dining Area for them including Glass panels between the flower beds. We would have loved to have been involved from the start on this one as we would have been able to improve the look further if we had designed and arranged for the flower beds to be built in accordance with the canopy. 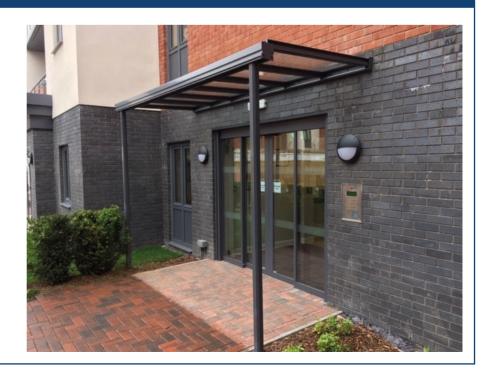


WHAT AN ENTRANCE

This great job was completed by R H Magor Joinery services in North Wales.

They have a contract with a housing developer and they were looking for a neat solution to give some weather protection to a main communal entrance. Russell has installed a number of Simplicity 6 systems in the past and put it forward on this project. The contemporary lines of the Simplicity 6 complement the building well and the standard RAL 7016 colourway made it an economical option.

The client is very impressed with the job and has now put in an order for another one on the same site, which could lead to a standard additional to future builds.



WHEN SIZE MATTERS

Check out this fantastic installation from Lifestyle Canopies of Blackburn, Lancs! It's a $12m \times 3m$ Simplicity 6 in RAL 8004 Copper Brown and it's one of the biggest domestic installations we've seen so far this year. Here's Steve Huckle (MD) to tell us about the job.

"The client was looking for a covering along the whole back of their home as they entertain a lot throughout the year and both the living room and dining room allow access to the patio area. Rather than have 2 smaller canopies above each patio door, they preferred to have a continuous canopy so that guests could move around the whole area in comfort. They liked the appeal of the profiles being 6m in length so as to avoid multiple joins in the gutter and having

the ability to match to a specific RAL colour meant that the Simplicity 6 was the best option against other systems that they had investigated. The house wall was all you could ask for in terms of a straightforward installation and Steve did a great job of templating the paving slab around the posts which were cast into the ground. The finishing touch were the modular heaters and we installed 4 of them along the back wall. If this weather keeps going it will be a while before they use them but it was and important add on so that the canopy could be used into the evening and all through the year. We have supplied and installed dozens of Milwood products and this met the usual high standard of product and delivery so happy customers all round!"

PAGE 1 OF GOOGLE IN 25 HOURS FOR SB CANOPIES

Last month, we talked about "Adding Products to your Website" (MMM Checklist Item #11) and I explained how one of our Trade Partners added 5 Milwood Products to their website, which in turn generated 109 Veranda/Canopy enquiries via the free listings on Google, without doing any other updates or advertising.

This month, we're going to discuss a related subject, which happens to be #16 on the Matrix Checklist, as shown here:

Optimise all your product and install pages for Google (Your 24-7 Sales Force)

BTW: To make it easier, we've now numbered the MMM 'Double Your Sales' Checklist Items (1-28) download your new copy at the link below.

When it comes to Optimising your Websites' product pages and completed installations pages, one of the first things you will want to do, is ensure your have added the 'Type' of product, such as Verandas etc., and the Geographical Locations you're working in, to your pages.

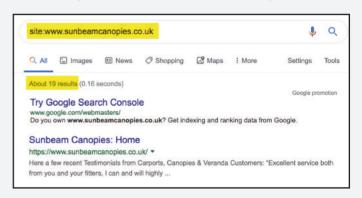
This process of adding 'keywords' in the right places on your website, is called: On-Page SEO.

I wrote my first book on SEO back in 2007, and 12 years on, On-Page SEO is still one of the fastest ways to move your website higher up the free listings on Google, if you have not already spent time optimising your website.

Updating your Website Title Tags and Page Descriptions is the best place to start.

To see your Title Tags and Descriptions, search on Google for 'site' 'colon' 'your-website-address'

For example: site:www.sunbeamcanopies.com



As you can see above, I used a site-colon search to show how Sunbeam Canopies Website Pages are listed (indexed) on Google.

Take a close look and the Title Tag (Sunbeam Canopies: Home) and Page Description (Under Website URL) they don't contain any locations, so I changed them to the new version below.

Derby based Sunbeam Canopies, specialist suppliers & installers of quality aluminium Garden Verandas, Awnings & Carports for Derbyshire & surrounding ...

Before I made this change, SB Canopies were on Page 2 of Google for Verandas, Canopies and Carports 'Derby or Derbyshire' but 25 hours later when I next checked, they were on Page 1.

"THE MORE YOU TELL, THE MORE YOU SELL!"

David Ogilvy, the "Father of Advertising"

One of my favourite quotes "The More You Tell, The More You Sell" which I included recently at the end of a 10,000 word (40 page) letter, which you may have seen.

Ironically, when I started an online marketing project a couple of years ago, at the time, my client's website also contained 10,000 words (across 50 pages) before our project began.

Those 50 pages (10,000 words) drove 300 people p/m to my clients website, generating £105k in Sales via Google/Website in the previous year.

Whereas, at the end of our 12-month project, their Website contained over 900 pages, (mostly completed jobs) and around 75,000 words.

At its peak, those 900 pages (75,000 words) were driving 1800 people p/m to their website...

...and for the year of our project, they generated £765k in Sales, from Google & their Website.

Telling their news to 1000's more people, in 65,000 more words on 850 more optimised web pages, linked and shared in 1000's more social posts/emails helped them sell £650k more.

In the following 12 months, without my help, but using the online marketing manual I created for them, their website visitors continued to grow, to over 2000 visitors (in May alone this year), which is helping them sell even more.

The difference between highly successful thriving businesses & those that struggle, usually boils down to a handful of easy to implement factics or strategies. When it comes to generating more customers & sales, nothing's really changed for decades, you just need to do more online now. So with that in mind, the big question is... are you checking these items off your list, regularly? Check a few items off this list to make a few extra sales... or to double your sales, check 'em all off!

PRODUCTS CHECKLIST

- Continually add new (and ideally more profitable) products to your range
- 2 Do competitor/supplier analysis to ensure your product info surpasses competitors

CUSTOMERS CHECKLIST

- 3 Encourage potential customers to subscribe to your lists (pixels, email, chat) 4 Inform new customers you'll exceed their expectation (helps generate reviews)
- 5 Educate new customers about old products & new products as they're launched
- 6 Educate existing/past customers about your new products, as they're launched

EMAIL CHECKLIST

- 7 Email leads with updates, offers and product information (at least monthly)
- Email new/past customers with updates about new/old products (at least monthly) 9 Email all customers who bought in last 30 days, for feedback/testimonials (monthly
- 10 Email new happy customers from last 90 days; ask for recommendations (quarterly

WEBSITES CHECKLIST

- Add all of your products to your website (1 product per page minimum)
- 12 Add your latest news/offers to your website blog or news pages (at least once a month) Gradually add all of your previous installations to your website (1 job per page)
- As new installations are completed, update your website (with reviews & testimonials)
- Contact other relevant Websites to feature your business, news and products

GOOGLE & GMB CHECKLIST

- Optimise all your product and install pages for Google (Your 24-7 Sales Force)
- Regularly add Google My Business 'Posts' about your Website Updates
- 18 Ensure your Google My Business Profile & Categories are Complete
- Gradually add your business details to Business Directories (Citations & Links)
- 20 Encourage relevant partners and suppli-to link back to your website (Backlinks)

SOCIAL MEDIA CHECKLIST

- 21 Create a rolling set of scheduled posts for all social media pages (1 click send to all)
- 22 Every time your website is updated, post to social (use 1 click send to all to save hours)
- 23 Check your social profile bio's are up to date with your latest product developments

OFFLINE CHECKLIST

- 24 Ensure all your offline marketing and advertising displays your website address
- 25 Use professionally printed brochures to create the right first impression
- 26 Display sales posters in your showroom to promote your new products and promo's
- 27 Each time you complete a survey or job, spend 5 mins leafleting neighbours doors
- People love stories, so include Case Studie in your printed presentation material
